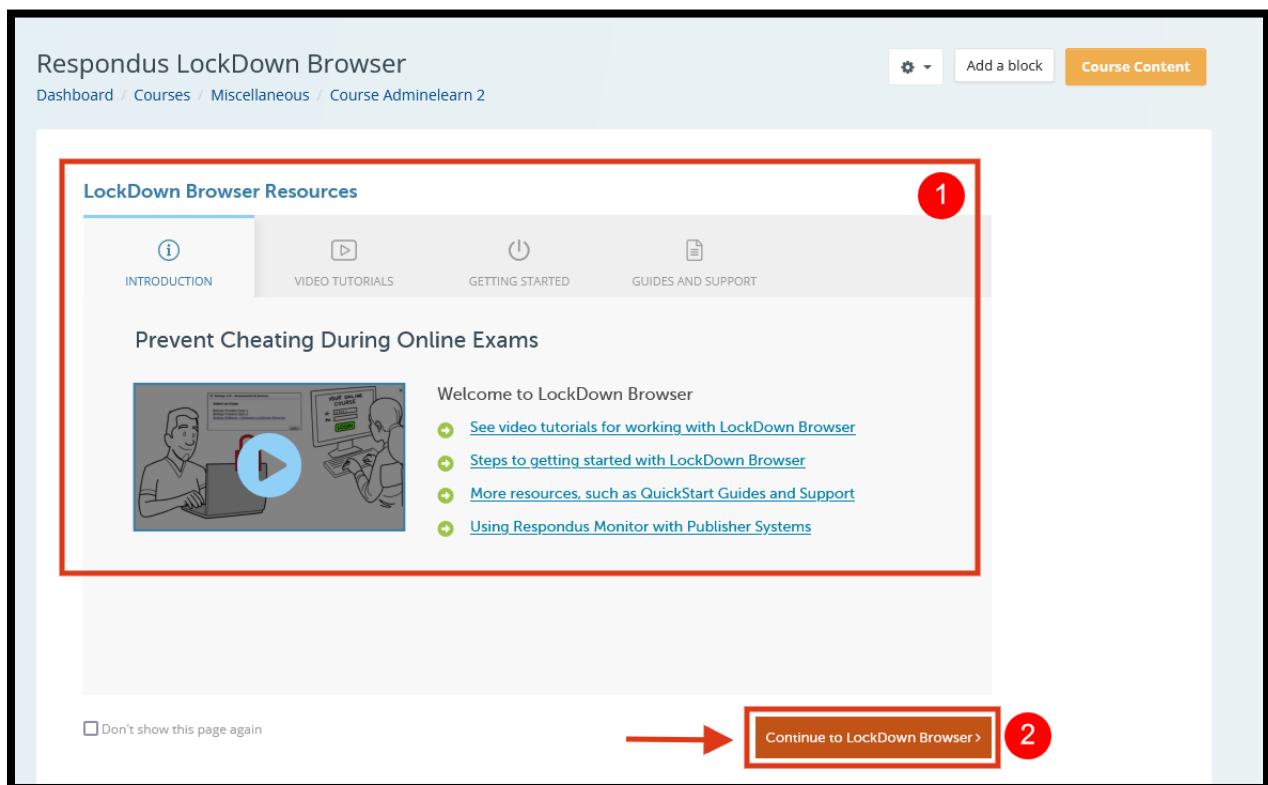
Setting the Lockdown browser for quizzes

Click on "Continue to Lockdown browser" to proceed.



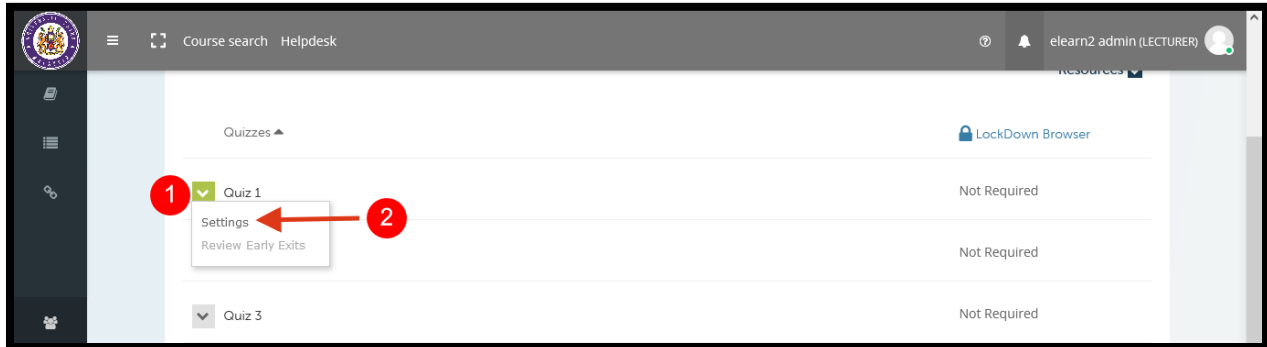
3. All the quizzes in the course will be listed in this page with Lockdown browser status.

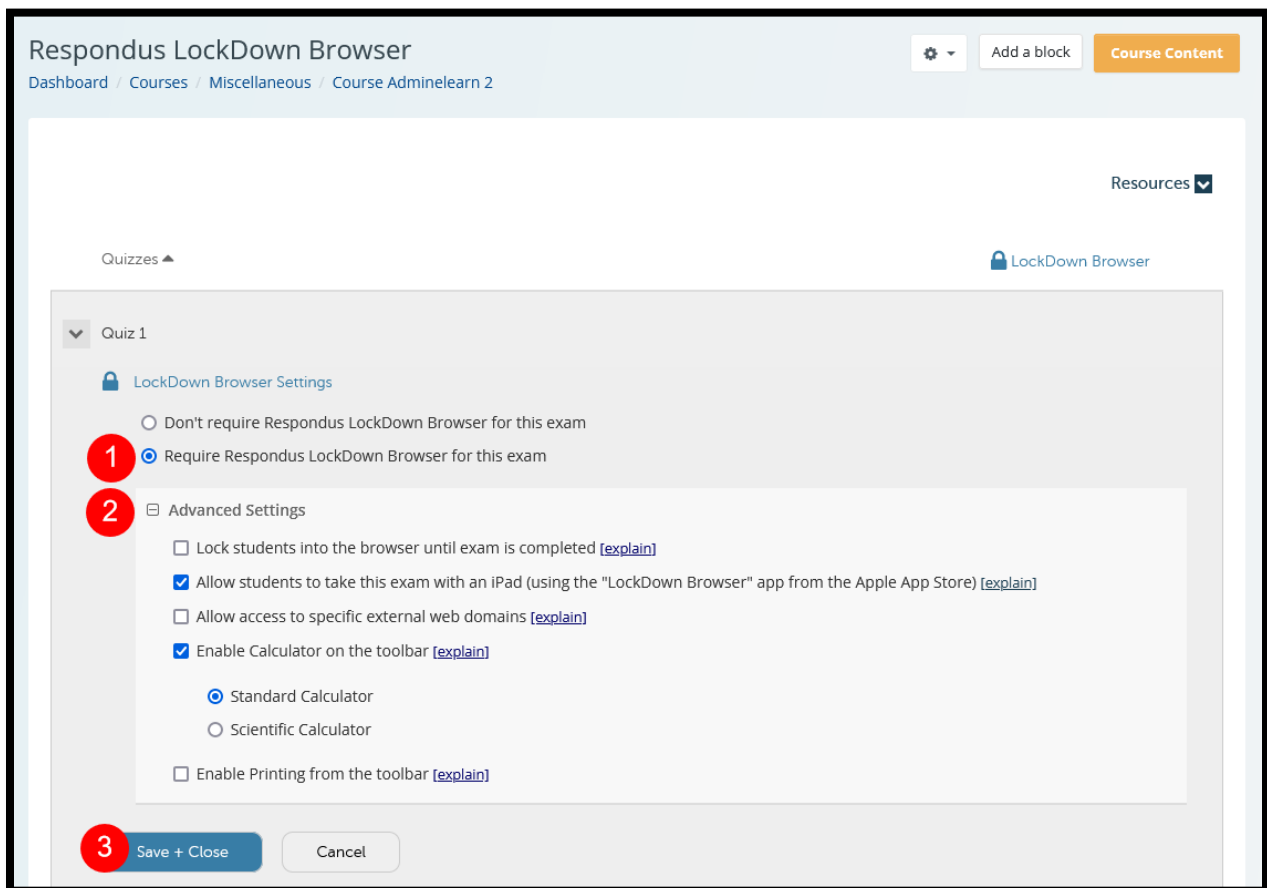

- i. Click required lockdown browser.
- ii. Open the advanced setting.
 - Choose appropriate setting
 - Recommendation:
 - ✓ Allow student to take exam using iPad
 - ✓ Enable calculator on toolbar
- iii. Click "Save +Close" button



6. The Lockdown Browser status will be update:
- i. Required – Set to use Lockdown Browser
 - ii. Not required – Use normal browser
